Dear Parents:

Fort Stockton ISD will be offering the H1N1 Flu Vaccine to all students of FSISD some time in January or February.

All students, ages 9 and under, must receive 2 doses of the H1N1 Vaccine to be properly immunized. The 2nd dose will be given 1 month after the first dose. All students aged 10 and older will only have to have 1 dose of the vaccine.

This H1N1 Vaccine will be offered at no cost to students. However, any and all insurance information (Medicaid, Private, Chips, etc) must be included with the child's packet. Please send a copy of your insurance information, along with the completed packet, back to the school (nurse) where your child attends school. This packet must be returned by **January 15, 2010**.

A notice will be sent out as to when your child is to receive the vaccine. Student's parents/guardians will have the option to be present during vaccine administration.

If you are interested in your child receiving the H1N1 Vaccine, please come to the school's office and pick up a packet. This packet must be filled out completely and returned to the school nurse by January 15, 2010.
