DRESS FOR SUCCESS GUIDE

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- All Standard Attire clothing may be purchased only one size larger than the student currently wears to allow for growth.
- Logos, artwork, or embroidery must be no larger than the size of a quarter coin. No oversized clothing is allowed.
- No tight fitting clothing is allowed.
- All clothing must be hemmed.
- No torn, cut, or ripped clothing is allowed.
- All Standard Attire clothing will follow the FSISD Student Code of Conduct dress code.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Shorts are only permissible in grades PK-5.

Students that violate the dress code are issued consequences through the principal's office. Any item not specifically addressed will be left to the discretion of the building administrator.

SHIRTS, SWEATSHIRTS, SWEATERS & CARDIGANS

- Colors allowed are khaki, royal blue, navy, white
- Shirts must be polo or oxford with collars
 - Long or short sleeves only (no sleeveless)
 - First button starting at collar (only top two buttons are allowed to be unbuttoned)
- Can be solid or striped in any combination of khaki, royal blue, navy or white
- Shirts must be tucked in all the way around
- Logos must be smaller than a quarter; No other artwork/lettering permitted
 - Exception – School Logo/Lettering: may be larger than a quarter
- Undershirts:
 - Solid crew neck t-shirts, turtlenecks, or thermals without writing or logos are allowed under collared shirts
 - Undershirt sleeves may be longer than outer shirt sleeves
- No hooded attire
- No pockets allowed on sweatshirts
- Panther clothing is allowed
- Not to be oversized, baggy, excessive in length (one size rule applies/can use shirt size as a rule)

PANTS OR CAPRIS

- Colors allowed are khaki, navy, and black
- No denim of any color, no cargo and no carpenter attire
- Corduroys are allowed
- No Cargo pockets of any kind on the legs
- All attire must fit properly on waist no more than one size larger than correct fit
- Length should not be longer than heel of shoe
- Pant/Capri legs must be fully extended; may not be rolled up

SHORTS, SKORTS, JUMPERS or SKIRTS

- Colors allowed are khaki, navy, and black
- Solid colors only
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts must fit properly on waist no more than one size larger than correct fit
- Shorts/Skirts/Skorts length needs to extend to the top of knee when clothing is correctly positioned at waist and standing
- No denim of any color, no cargo and no carpenter attire
- Collared shirt must be worn under jumper
- Shorts are only permissible in grades PK-5

BELTS

- Must be solid black or brown leather
- Must be worn in the belt loops with pants, skirts, and shorts that have belt loops
- No visible brands or logos
- Trophy/display belt buckles not allowed

OUTERWEAR

- Must be stored in locker upon entering the building

MISCELLANEOUS

- Ripped or torn clothing is not permitted
- Writing or embroidery is regulated by rules that apply to logos
- Leggings and tights permitted in solid khaki, navy, royal, black or white and must be worn under approved clothing

SHOES

- Shoes must be worn at all times

SPIRIT DAYS

- Spirit Days are on Fridays and other days as designated by the campus principal
- Panther shirts or college shirts (NO JERSEYS) may be substituted for the regular standard attire shirt
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times and worn with standard attire pants, skirts, shorts, and jumpers
- Spirit shirts do not have to be collared
- No homemade spirit shirts or pants will be allowed

BEFORE YOU BUY

Parents are ultimately responsible for making sure their child follows the Standard Attire Policy. If you are in doubt or have any questions about the Standard Attire Policy, please call the campus office.

The campus principal may revise or adjust the dress code as necessary at her/his discretion for special situations.
