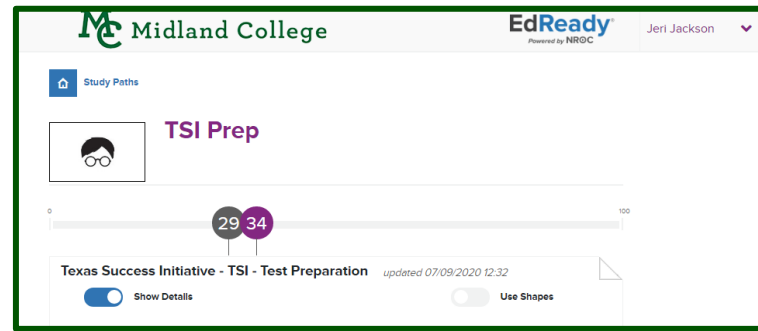

Step 1: New User

Returning – Just log in



Step 2: Test Set Up

Select TSI prep “Goals” if new, you will take a diagnostic test that will give you a “TSI Test Preparation” percent with a study plan.

Returning - you will already have a “TSI Test Preparation” percent.

Step 3: Practice, Practice, Practice!

As you work in the 11 categories listed with success, your score will improve. Once your score reaches over 80%, you will need to email this report to emails listed below.

Step 4: Sending Score Report

My account - Go to the top right hand corner where your name is at. Click the arrow down button right next to your name located in the right top corner of the page.

Student Data Export - Toward the bottom of the page you will select “Download your data”. You will put in this email address: jjackson@midland.edu. This will send a report to the college letting them know you have an 80% or better on your math and need to be approved for testing.

Deadline – Report must be sent by 9 PM two days before testing. Example: testing on Thursday by 9 PM Tuesday evening report must be sent. This will give us both time to make adjustments to scheduled test day if needed.

Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0

The purpose of the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) program is to guide Texas public institutions of higher education in determining whether entering, non-exempt students are ready for entry-level college coursework in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics through the administration of the Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA2.0). Students who do not meet one or more of the established benchmarks of the TSIA2.0 are required to participate in developmental education support prior to, or together with, enrollment in college-level coursework.

TSIA2 NEW INFORMATION

What's New?

The Reading and Writing Sections of the TSIA are combined to form ELAR. These tests can no longer be taken as separate exams. The new scoring system includes an opportunity for students to pass using their diagnostic score if they do not initially meet college readiness.

ELAR TSIA2

College Readiness Scores

CRC: 945 - 990 AND Essay: 5 - 8

OR

CRC: 910-944 AND Diagnostic Level: 5-6 AND Essay: 5-8

MATH TSIA2

College Readiness Scores

CRC: 950 - 990

OR

CRC: 910-949 AND Diagnostic Level: 6

Preparing for the TSIA 2.0

Accuplacer link -<https://accuplacerpractice.collegeboard.org/login>

Sign up for an account – pick TSI test – pick the subject in which you will be testing.
(Example if testing in just Reading – just Score Report for Reading. But if you are testing in Reading and Writing – you will need a sample test for Reading and Writing.)

Step 1: Practice, Practice, Practice:

You have two options on how to study!

- “Learn as you go”.** This will provide immediate feedback after each question is submitted and includes an explanation for the correct response. Use this version to review the test content areas and to prepare for the **Sample Test** version. You can do this as many times as you need.
- “Sample Test”.** Remember this is not the actual ACCUPLACER® test, but it resembles the test-taking experience. Use this version after you have had a chance to review the test content with the **Learn As You Go** version. This test is not designed to serve as a substitute for an actual ACCUPLACER test, nor does it guarantee that you will receive a specific score on an actual ACCUPLACER test.

Step 2: Make an 80% or better score:

Once you complete a test that shows an 80% or better, you can see the progress on your previous scores. Go to top of page and select History. You can take a picture or snapshot the scores and email it to the address above. It must show your email address, score, and date of test. This test is not designed to serve as a substitute for an actual ACCUPLACER® test, nor does it guarantee that you will receive a specific score on an actual ACCUPLACER test. This will help you see the areas in which you need to work.
